

ORDINANCE NO. 12-06-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SOUTHERN VIEW CODE TO
CONFORM TO THE ILLINOIS VIDEO GAMING ACT, P.A. 96-34

WHEREAS, the Illinois State General Assembly has investigated and determined that video gaming may be allowed in Illinois subject to rigid regulation, and:

WHEREAS, the Southern View Board of Trustees has discussed the intention of certain establishments within the Village to apply for Terminal Operator permits from the Illinois Gaming Board allowing regulated video gaming, and:

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees desires to amend certain Ordinances of the Village of Southern View to conform with the new requirements imposed by the Illinois General Assembly in Public Act 96-34, and:

WHEREAS, the following Ordinances of the Village of Southern View are amended as provided to allow video gaming pursuant to Illinois Law.

NOW THEN, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Southern View, Sangamon County, Illinois:

Section One:

Section 134.09, GAMBLING, of the Southern View Code of Ordinances is amended by adding the following language prior to the existing paragraph:

"Except as otherwise permitted by Illinois Law and Chapter 135, GAMBLING OFFENSES, of this Code of Ordinances, "

Section Two:

Section 135.02(b), GAMBLING, of the Southern View Code of Ordinances is amended by adding the following new paragraph (12) at the end of subsection (b):

"(12) Gambling games conducted in authorized establishments offering video gaming pursuant to 230 ILCS 40/1 *et seq.* "

Section Three:

That if any part or parts of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

Section Four:

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately on and after its passage, approval and publication pursuant to Illinois law.
